Israel AIDS Task Force

The Israeli Aids Task Force is responsible for the education and prevention of AIDS and for the protection and support of people living with AIDS in Israel.

We have supported this group since 2001.

During 2018:

GSK provided a core funding and donation of £ 16,964, for:

- 3 months' workshop
- Annual conference for Ethiopian population living with HIV (1 day during May)
- 1 art exhibition during World AIDS day (Nov-Dec)
- 1 roaming exhibition following World AIDS day
- Dedicated mini-site production up to 10 articles dealing with various HIV topics.
- Information booklet for HIV positive patients

Our support represented ~5% of their overall income

The Israel Association for Pulmonary Hypertension (IPAH)

IPAH advocates for funding of treatments and consults on issues relating to patient rights. They provide support to patients and help raise awareness of the condition.

We have supported this group since 1998.

During 2018:

GSK provided a core funding of £ 3,750, for:

- Support to the organisation in delivering its objectives.
- Annual conference
- Support improving digital communication
- Support activities for patient groups and their family

Our support represented ~15% of their overall income



The Society for Patients' Rights in Israel

This organization helps patients and their families claim their healthcare rights and obtain necessary services from the health plans, hospitals and other medical facilities.

We have supported this group since 2011.

During 2018:

• GSK provided a project funding of £ 1,785 for yearly support and annual conference.
