Korean Lupus Support Group

The Korean Lupus Support Group was founded in 1997 and authorized by the government in 1999 as a patient network supporting Lupus patients.

- Providing monetary support to Lupus patient
- Providing patients with disease information
- Holding consulting program for Lupus patient
- Monetary support to Lupus patients in need

This group organizes the World Lupus Day event in Korea with an aim to raise the awareness of disease burden and the unmet needs of patients.

We have supported this group since 2013.

During 2016:

- GSK provided a Project funding of 2,000,000 KRW for supporting the World Lupus Day event
- 10 GSK Korea employees participated in world Lupus Day activity as a volunteer

Korean Lukemia patient Group

The Korean Lukemia Patient Group was founded in 2002 and authorized by the Ministry of Health and Welfare in 2002 as a patient network to support Lukemia patients. This group organizes the various patient welfare and support programmes to enhance patient care.

During 2016:

- GSK provided a core funding of 3,000,000 KRW
- GSK's fund used to operate these following programmes; Clean car, Clean cinema, Patient network meeting, Blood donation talk talk concert, patient story book and outdoor activity.

Our support represented 1.5% of their overall income

During 2014:

- GSK provided a Project funding of 5,000,000 KRW for supporting the their clean car service for the leukaemia patients
- Philanthropic cash donation to support to operate their clean car service for the leukaemia patients
- The clean cars are used to support patient's safe commute to the hospitals.
