

# Global patient group funding

## Meningitis Research Foundation

### During 2019:

GlaxoSmithKline made the following grants to Meningitis Research Foundation (MRF):

- £30,000 Core funding to assist in strengthening the patient voices in UK/Europe and building global advocacy
- £50,000 Project funding for the continued development of the Global Meningococcal Genome Library and Meningitis Progress Tracker
- £35,000 Sponsorship of MRF's 12<sup>th</sup> Scientific Conference in November 2019 including for a stand and symposium at the bi-annual conference

Our support represented 5% of their overall income.

### During 2018:

GlaxoSmithKline made the following grants to Meningitis Research Foundation (MRF):

- £60,000 Core funding to assist strengthening the patient voice & build partnership
- £25,000 Project funding for the development of the Global Meningococcal Genome Library
- £30,000 Project funding to support the development of a global meningitis data website

Our support represented 3.9% of their overall income.

### During 2017:

- GSK provided sponsorship of £30,00 for a stand and symposium at the bi-annual conference
- GSK provided funding of £3,000 towards the cost of filming at The Meningitis Research Foundation Conference 2017
- GSK provided £117,000 to support 'voice of the patient' programme for the prevention of meningitis
- GSK provided £15,000 for a 3 day summit on 'A Global Vision for Meningitis by 2030 and an Action Plan to get there'

Our support represented 5.6% of their overall income.

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
