Why?..



Ireland has one of the fastest ageing populations in Europe¹



Chronic diseases are increasing, with 74% of >58-year-olds living with comorbidities²



With healthcare utilisation and costs rising³, it is cheaper to prevent rather than treat disease



Adult immunisation programmes could save up to €23 for every €1 spent in Ireland⁴



Anti-microbial resistance is a significant threat⁵



80% of vaccines in development are aimed towards adults⁶

the development of a whole-of-government immunisation strategy for Ireland, promoting a life-course framework to vaccination, based on these four strategic pillars
